COLONEL JOSIAH L. MEYERS

Colonel Josiah L. Meyers is the Wing Vice Commander, 110th Wing, W.K. Kellogg Air National Guard Base, Battle Creek, Michigan. He is Wing Vice Commander of approximately 1,000 personnel where his responsibilities include oversight of four groups and several tenant units. The groups include an Operations Group, Mission Support Group, Medical Group, and an Air Operations Group. The tenant units include the Defense Logistics Agency, STARBASE, AAFES, Michigan State Police, and the Merit Network. The 110th Attack Wing has 241 full-time technicians and Active Guard Reservists; drill status manning is 579 personnel.

Col Meyers earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering from Michigan Technological University in 1998, and later earned a Master of Science degree from the University of Michigan-Dearborn. He began his military career in the U.S. Navy and was commissioned in Pensacola, Florida in 1998. As a Civil Engineer Corps officer, Col Meyers was stationed at Naval District Washington and Naval Station North Island, where he served as Staff Civil Engineer for Naval Special Warfare Group ONE. He transferred to the Michigan Air National Guard in 2003, serving as a base engineer at the Alpena Combat Readiness Training Center for 10 years, executing over \$40 million in construction projects to modernize the training facility. In 2013, he was assigned as commander of the 110th Civil Engineer Squadron at Battle Creek ANG Base, where he led design and construction of an MQ-9 operations facility in support of the 110th Attack Wing mission conversion. Col Meyers served as commander of the 110th Logistics Readiness Squadron from 2016 until 2017. Prior to assuming his current position, he was the Commander, 110th Mission Support Group.
